









As of October 19, 2012, Assembly Bill 1343 established the PaintCare Inc., program.

The program will make proper paint management more convenient for the public by setting up hundreds of new paint drop-off sites at retailers throughout the state. California is the second state in the nation to develop and implement this program, with Oregon being the first and Connecticut and Rhode Island soon to follow. Paint manufacturers, through the American Coatings Association, created PaintCare, a non-profit organization to administer state programs. The non-profit will arrange for recycling and proper disposal of unused paint and conduct public education about proper paint management.

Restrictions: Limit: 20 gallons (or posted amount of gallons per store)
These sites accept latex and oil-based house paint, stains and varnish in containers up to 5-20 gallons in size. These sites do NOT accept aerosols (spray paint or other spray products), containers without original labels, or containers that are empty or leaking.
