The Orange County Grant Jury released a report that included critiques of OCAC operations. This report will be reviewed by staff and a response provided within 90 days. The County Executive Office will be the lead on the response. The report raises questions about rather complicated procedures we have in place due to the nature of the animal care industry.

We plan to meet bi-monthly going forward.

Budget Update

Projected to come in slightly under total NOI. Contract cities will receive Q4 bill sometime in August 2023. Final numbers to be shared at the August CMAACC meeting. Costs are increasing overall, which was touched on at our last meeting. Inflation, increased relinquishments, and the cost of care are key drivers. Thanks to all that have signed NOI's.

Operational Update

We've made some changes to the outdoor portion of the shelter to reduce stress for animals. May 2023 was a great month for large dog adoptions. We've been waiving fees and doing whatever we can to help these dogs find homes.

We're working with Petco to provide adoptable kittens and are fully live. Program is operated by volunteers. Foster opportunities are abundant.

Outside-the-box event ideas are being discussed to ensure we have a successful summer of adoptions.


- o Projected \$243K under NOI as of 05-31-23

Installation of Shade Cloth to Reduce Stress for Dogs

- Shade cloth has been installed around portions of the dog kennels and yards to reduce the level of visual stimuli our dogs are exposed to.
- These barriers help reduce reactivity and frustration the dogs may experience in kennel and reduce the overall stress level when there is foot traffic on the promenade.

Adoption Program Successes

- Waiv ed adoption fees for dogs 25+ lbs
 - We continue to see the fee waiver help medium and large size dogs find their forever family.
 - In May 2023, a 31 percent increase was seen in adoptions for dogs 25+ pounds compared to the adoption rates in May 2022!
- Pooches on the Patio
 - Since launching Pooches on the Patio in October 2022, we have had over 50 large dog adoptions!

Operational Update

We are excited to be back at the Petco Cattery in Orange!

- In 2022, 207 kittens were adopted from the Petco Cattery.
- This program is fully operated by volunteers.

Volunteer Foster Caretakers

- There are currently over 200 kittens and 6 puppies in foster homes!
- Our foster team is consistently recruiting new foster families.
 Opportunities to learn more about the foster program includes:
 - Kitten Shower: live bottle-feeding demos, training opportunities as well as an 'Ask an RVT' booth.
 - June 24 at 10 a.m.
 - Kitten Club: a monthly forum to learn how to care for underage kittens, in a fun and engaging format.
 - July 1 at 2 p.m.
