The City will be presenting to Council updates on a number of projects with a focus on those that will require ROW takes. To that end, whichever projects you are working on that will require ROW takes or impacts, please prepare a ROW impact graphic similar to that which is attached (props to the BKF team for this one – remember copy is the greatest form of flattery).

Here is what I see as far as projects with ROW impact:

### **BKF**

Los Alisos/Muirlands – hopefully you have been able to revise the design to avoid takes from mobile home park and other single residential property.

### **Rick Engineering**

Bake/Toledo – show ROW on both Lake Forest and Irvine side with emphasis on Lake Forest side

Jerónimo/Lake Forest – this project has been rescoped to eliminate the need for ROW take; however, the widening into landscape area which is City ROW I think should be shown as removal of landscape which will be somewhat of an impact on that neighborhood but there are no ROW takes.

Los Alisos/Rockfield – there is currently discussion about rescoping this project to eliminate the need to relocate overhead electrical lines and TCEs for constructing new retaining walls along rear properties of residential properties.

### **Tait**

Jerónimo/El Toro – there is a good ROW mapping prepared that has been beneficial for our PDT meetings; however, I feel that something similar to that which is attached which shows ROW impacts on top of an aerial photo is a better graphic for Council presentation.
