

CITY MANAGER'S MESSAGE

LAKE FOREST, THE NATURAL CHOICE FOR BUSINESS

2018 was an exciting year for Lake Forest, filled with new neighborhoods, construction of the Civic Center, hotels and businesses, and paying off the last of the City's debt. LandSea Homes at IronRidge held the grand opening of The Ridge, a recreation center featuring a resort-style beach entry pool, spa and splash pad, an expansive event lawn, and multiple playgrounds. The master-planned community off Glen Ranch Road will consist of six distinct neighborhoods, the City's 31st park, second dog park, and community center.

Construction of the Lake Forest Civic Center, the City's "100 Year Home," is underway. The Civic Center campus will feature several community amenities, including a Community Center, Senior Center, Council Chamber/Performing Arts Center. City Council unamiously approved 22 construction contracts for the Civic Center and, in August, construction crews began pouring concrete pads for the Performing Arts Center and the Community Center. In January, City officials watched as the last piece of steel was hoisted into place. The Civic Center is scheduled to open this Fall.

Visitors and business travelers to Lake Forest will soon have access to an even wider selection of hotels and suites that offer something for everybody. Three hotels are under construction, adding over 240,000 sq. ft. and 422 rooms to the City's hotel inventory. The new hotels are near Lake Forest Drive and Rockfield Boulevard. In addition to three new hotels, the City also is welcoming three new employers: Hoag Health, At Home, and Sprouts. Hoag Health Center and At Home, a national home decor and furnishings store, are coming to the Foothill Ranch Towne Centre. Sprouts, a full-service, 29,000 sq. ft. grocery store featuring natural and organic products, will open in the Hunter Court Shopping Center off El Toro Road and Rockfield Boulevard.

In December, the City officially became debt-free. Lake Forest was already just one of eight cities in the California Public Retirement System (CalPERS) with no pension liabilities. By paying off its last \$7 million bond, Lake Forest became the largest CalPERS City in the state with zero debt. December was the earliest the City could retire its only outstanding bonds, which paid for the extension of Alton Parkway.

PROJECT UPDATES

CIVIC CENTER UPDATE - NEW MILESTONES

Progress at the Civic Center continues as the City reaches new milestones in the construction of the City's "100 Year Home". In April, the City Council approved 22 contracts that represent the bulk of the work to finish construction of the Civic Center. In August, construction crews began pouring concrete pads for the Performing Arts and Community Centers.

The Civic Center will feature public facilities that address several community needs including a Community Center,

Senior Center, Council Chambers/Performing Arts Venue, rentable meeting space, and City Hall. It will be on a 12-acre site in the vicinity of Commercentre Drive and Civic Center Drive, alongside the future Serrano Summit housing development. The Civic Center is expected to open in the Fall of this year.
