

Applicant's Guide to Submitting ACCESSORY DWELLING UNIT PERMIT APPLICATION

PURPOSE:

An Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) Permit and building permit are required prior to the construction of any ADU subject to the provisions of LFMC Sec. 9.146.050 (D)(2)

APPLICATION FILING:

ADU Permit Applications may be submitted to the Community Development Department Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Wednesday 8:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m., and Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Community Development counter is closed for lunch 11:45 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Applications will be acted upon ministerially within 60 days of receipt of a complete application. The 60-day timeline will be tolled for incomplete applications or upon written request of the applicant. APPLICATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

The following information is required upon submittal:

- 1. Completed Accessory Dwelling Unit Permit application (including property owner approval signature).
- 2. A completed City of Lake Forest address assignment application for the proposed ADUs/JADUs.
- 3. Three sets of full-size, fully-dimensioned, to-scale project plans, one set of plans reduced to 8½" x 11", and one digital set of plans in PDF format provided on a CD, flash drive or via e-mail. All full-sized plan sets must be folded to 8½" x 11". All plans shall contain the following information:
 - a. A site plan depicting all proposed and existing improvements, including, but not limited to: property lines; buildings and building floor areas; building setbacks (from property lines); parking spaces, driveways; ultimate street right-of-way lines, sidewalks; easements (location, dimensions, purpose); landscaped areas; walls and fences.
 - b. Fully-dimensioned complete and annotated floor plans for all existing and proposed structures uses.
 - c. Building elevations depicting all sides of all proposed structures, and including any existing structure(s) to which the proposed ADU is attached.
 - d. Project address on each sheet of the plan set.
 - e. Name and address of property owner and applicant on title sheet.
 - f. Drawing scale for all plans/elevations.
 - g. North arrow on all plan-view drawings.
 - h. Drawn date.
