A Message From City Manager DEBRA ROSE

City Council direction and public input plays a big role in developing the Lake Forest budget each year, but staff also relies on the Strategic Business Plan to ensure the spending aligns with the City's long-range goals.

Lake Forest has three long-term goals, which were also developed with the City Council:

- A livable city that is well planned, attractive and safe.
- A city that is engaged, informed, and technologically current.
- A city government that is fiscally sustainable and well-run with committed staff.

At the start of the budgeting process, staff develops strategies to reach those goals. A strategy for meeting the goal of being well planned, for example, is to prioritize traffic improvements. A strategy to meet the goal of being an attractive City is our continual reinvestment in City parks. Our goal of creating an engaged community can be met with new outreach tools.

Staff then links specific projects with the strategies. More than 20 traffic-improvement projects address the strategy of reducing traffic congestion. Park improvements at the Arbors and a half-dozen other parks address the strategy to ensure Lake Forest remains an attractive community. Our new government channel at 851 on Cox Communications and radio broadcasts at AM 1690 fulfill the strategy of increasing engagement with new tools.

These are just a few examples. The Strategic Business Plan, a seven-year document, identifies 61 special projects to ensure we meet our three primary goals. The Strategic Plan is more important than ever, as new residential neighborhoods will be finished over the next seven years, moving the City from a developing community to a "maintenance City." That transition will make it more important than ever for Lake Forest to invest in infrastructure and provide programs in a thoughtful – strategic – way to ensure Lake Forest continues to meet our goals of being attractive, engaged, and well-run.

E-BIKES: USE THEM SAFELY, USE THEM LEGALLY!

As the popularity of E-bikes continues to increase, it is critical we all do our part to ensure safety in our streets and be mindful of all motorized vehicles in the roadway.

SAFETY TIPS FOR ELECTRIC BICYCLES:

- 1. Always wear a helmet. No exceptions.
- 2. Make sure your bike has front and rear lights, as well as reflective stickers.
- 3. Wear bright, reflective clothing.
- Install a horn so that motorists can hear you coming. Bicyclists and even motorcycles can be quiet and easily lost in a motorist's blind spot.
- 5. Find safe routes-preferably less traveled roads and pathways that allow electric bikes.
- 6. Ride defensively. Don't assume anyone can see or hear you. Anticipate what drivers and pedestrians might do, and act accordingly.
- 7. Beware of parked cars. Someone could open their car door as you pass or pull out of their parking spot without looking.
- 8. Look out for other bicyclists, who may not have lights at night or may dart out in front of you.
- 9. Let pedestrians know you're coming with an announcement of "On your left!" or a beep of the horn. Always slow down when approaching pedestrians.
- 10. Ride with traffic and always obey traffic rules (i.e. stop at stop signs and red lights, ride on the right side of the road, not the sidewalk, etc.). Be aware of cracks and potholes.
- 11. Loose gravel and wetness can be risky too. Slow down, be cautious, and avoid those conditions if possible.

Remember, cars make mistakes too! Drivers often don't always use their turn signals, speed and make sudden lane changes. Always be alert and aware of your surroundings.

Electric bikes - California Vehicle Code Section 312.5(a)

Class 1: Low speed, pedal-assisted electric bicycle – Provides assistance only when rider is pedaling, ceases to assist once bicycle rider reaches 20 mph.

Class 2: Low speed, throttle assisted electric bicycle – Equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle, ceases to assist once the bicycle reaches 20 mph

Class 3: "speed pedal-assisted electric bicycle -- Equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling, and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 28 miles per hour, and equipped with a speedometer.

All classes of electric bicycles fall under the same California Vehicle Code rules as regular bicycles. Additionally, Lake Forest Municipal Code 13.04.12 says "No person shall operate a bicycle on a non-roadway recklessly." It is also a misdemeanor under California Vehicle Code 23103 to "pop a wheelie" or drive recklessly. The bicycle can be confiscated.


KNOW YOUR EVAC ZONES

Did you know Lake Forest is divided into 30 evacuation zones? Even more importantly, do you know what zone your home or business is in? In a wildfire or other emergency, the Orange County Sheriff's Department and City will notify those in Lake Forest of potential evacuations by zone.

The map will also be updated during an emergency to show which zones are under evacuation warnings, or full evacuations. And while the information is on the City's wildfire page, remember other emergencies, such as explosions or gas leaks, could lead to evacuations, as well.


- The Sports Park Recreation Center opens 8 am to 10 pm Monday through Saturday, and on Sunday 10 am to 6 pm.


LAKE FOREST MOVES TO TWO-YEAR BUDGET


The City Council in June approved a balanced budget that for the first time incorporates two fiscal years instead of one. The two-year budget allows City leaders to better focus on long-term and strategic aspects of City spending.

The 2021-23 spending plan maintains City services and continues to provide the services that address the priorities of the community. Total General Fund revenues are projected to be \$53.2 million in Fiscal Year 2021-22 and \$54.2 million in Fiscal Year 2022-23.

Total General Fund expenditures are projected to be \$51.2 million in Fiscal Year 2021-22 and \$51.4 million in Fiscal Year 2022-23. The Capital Improvement Plan for the 2021-23 budget cycle includes 25 projects totaling \$19.4 million. The projects include 13 traffic improvement projects, seven street improvement projects, and five park improvement projects.

The City's 2021-2028 Financial Forecast maintains a balanced operating budget for the next six fiscal years, generating an accumulated operating surplus of \$8.6 million. See more at **bit.ly/LFFiscalTransparency**.

LAKE FOREST NEEDS YOUR INPUT!



The City seeks input about the vision for the future of mixed-use zoning in Lake Forest.

The mixed-use zoning includes a blend of homes and commercial or industrial projects as well as shared open space.

As part of the City of Lake Forest's General Plan Update 2040, mixed-use land use designations were adopted. These new designations allow for a blend of residential and complementary retail, hotel, office, and/ or industrial uses in key focus areas in the City. These mixed-use areas would offer walkable streets, vibrant open spaces, and plazas, along with diverse housing options for people to live, work, shop, and recreate.

CHANGES COMING TO COUNCIL DISTRICTS

Just as Lake Forest finished its transition to District-based Council elections with the 2020 contest, the lines are now required to be redrawn. The California Voters Rights Act mandates districts be updated every 10 years with new Census data. The City of Lake Forest expects results from the Census in September, which will allow public input and hearings on adjusting the district boundaries.

In August, the City will consider a contract with a demographer to help ensure the new districts are properly balanced and comply with all regulations.

Lake Forest moved to district elections for the 2018 Council election under the threat of a California Voting Rights Act lawsuit. Three Council members were elected by district in 2018; the transition was completed in 2020 when the two remaining Lake Forest seats moved to districts.

ADOPTION CENTER CELEBRATES FOUR YEARS IN LAKE FOREST

The Pet Adoption Center of Orange County is celebrating its fourth anniversary in Lake Forest, thanks to you, the local community. The Pet Adoption Center houses dogs approximately 30 pounds and under at its Lake Forest Village adoption center. To provide the best service possible to potential adopters, the center is open by appointment only.

Along with taking in dogs from owners no longer able to keep them and providing referrals to those we are unable to house, the PAC-OC provides the community with a variety of services to assist them with adopting and caring for their pet. The Center also offers counseling to those who would like to keep their pets but are having difficulties. In conjunction with local veterinarians, PAC-OC assists with locating low-cost spay/neuter, vaccination, and microchipping services.

While the Pet Adoption Center-Orange County always offers dog adoption services through its website, the Center also participates in quarterly adoption events.

The PAC-OC has volunteer opportunities for students 16-17 years old, with an adult volunteering with them. Adult volunteers are also needed.

APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE FOR NEIGHBORHOOD PRIDE PAINT PROGRAM

The City has established its Neighborhood Pride Paint Program to maintain and improve the character, aesthetic quality and property values within the community. The program is funded with the City's Community Development Block Grant and provides the opportunity for qualified residents to have the exterior of their home painted at no cost to the homeowner. Program qualifications include:

- Properties must be owner-occupied
- The home or mobile home must need painting as determined by the City
- Owners cannot have assets in excess of \$120,000, excluding the value of the home
- The existing exterior paint must be lead-free
- Homeowners must not exceed maximum low-income limits listed below, as determined by household size defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the previous 2 years.

CUT WATER WASTE CUT POLLUTION

Did you know that you could be spending your money only to waste water and contribute to pollution?

Many people may not realize that about 50 percent of water used in the home is used for outdoor irrigation. When sprinklers over spray water on areas without landscaping, such as sidewalks and patio surfaces, or when landscaping is over watered and the soil becomes saturated, the excess water runoff can travel over sidewalks, driveways, streets, and gutters. As it travels, it picks up pollutants on its way to the storm drain. Because runoff can carry pollutants to the storm drain system, it is designated as a prohibited discharge in the Lake Forest Municipal Code.

Consider this—a typical residential sprinkler can emit about one gallon a minute. If a lawn with 10 spray heads was over watered by five minutes daily, 50 gallons of water could be wasted every day! Irrigation runoff can also pick up and carry motor oil, pesticides, pet wastes, pathogens/bacteria, nitrates, toxic metals, and household chemicals to the storm drain system. Unlike the sewer system, the runoff water is not treated and the storm drain system conveys this polluted water directly to our creeks, lakes, and beaches. Paying a little attention to your irrigation system to eliminate irrigation runoff pays off big – it fights pollution, conserves our limited water resources, and can save you money! Here are some smart and easy tips to eliminate over-irrigation and runoff:

- Do not over-water. Most plants do not need to be watered every day, especially lawns. Generally, reduce your sprinkler cycle length and increase the number of cycles. Use a water calculator at www.bewaterwise.com/ calculator.html
- 2. Water lawns before sunrise, or after sunset. This will maximize water absorption into the soil and minimize loss due to evaporation or wind.
- 3. Watch out for misdirected sprinklers. Keep water on the plants—there's no benefit to watering the sidewalk or street. Also, periodically inspect and fix leaks.
- 4. Consider the use of native and drought resistant California plants for your landscaping. There are over 6,000 varieties to choose from, and they typically use about two-thirds less water.

INTRODUCING YOUR ORGANICS RECYCLING CART

Your green waste refuse cart became your Organics Recycling Cart on July 1. You can now discard food waste with your green waste, making it organic waste.

Organic waste, including food waste, is the largest material type placed in California landfills. As organic waste decomposes, methane is released, which contributes to climate change. Organic waste recycling is good for the environment and it's the law. In 2016, to reduce methane, California adopted SB 1383 which mandates a reduction in organic waste in landfills.

How does it work?

Use a bowl, pail, or compostable bag to collect food scraps and then simply toss the scraps in your Organics Cart. Place your Organics Cart out with your trash and recycling carts on your usually collection day.

What if you don't have a green waste cart?

Over the next few months, CR&R will deliver 35-gallon

Organics Carts to residents without a green cart. If you live in multi-family homes that use a community bin, CR&R will work with your community management to arrange for organics collection.

Already compost in your backyard?

Great! Keep composting. Everyone is encouraged to reduce food waste by planning meals, storing food properly, and using up leftovers. But there will always be some waste such as avocado pits and banana peels. If you're already composting, you're a step ahead.

Lake Forest is home to the Etnies Skatepark of Lake Forest, one of the world's best skateparks. From beginner to advanced features, the park has terrain for all levels of skateboarders.

Etnies is staffed and offers some radical lessons, camps, and events. Did you know the largest skateboard lesson ever taught was held at the skatepark and is still a current Guinness World Record? Or that the park was named one of the top ten places to ride before you die in Transworld Skateboard Magazine?

The park, which opened December 13, 2003 and expanded on August 20, 2011, features competition bowls, back yard style pools, giant flow sections, and a world class street area. The private—public partnership with Lake Forest-based Etnies, the world-class skate shoe manufacturer, was a perfect fit. Three locals who grew up skating at the park are now professional include Dylan Witkin, Aidan Campbell, and Daniel Vargas. They were all on the first ever Lake Forest City Skateboard Team.

The Etnies Skatepark of Lake Forest has over 62,000 square feet of concrete waiting for you to come out and gets some grinds on this summer. Stop by and shred, but don't forget your helmet!



• \$10.00 Lost Card Fee - A \$10 fee will be charged to any taxi participant who has lost their card and requires a replacement card.


- 1. All programs are subject to cancellation or schedule changes.
- 2. We do not pro-rate any of our classes or programs; late registrants will be obligated to pay full price for the course.
- 3. In the case that we receive your Program Registration Form and the activity is full, we will put you on the wait list.
- 4. Please submit a separate check for each program with your registration form. In the case that you do submit one check for numerous activities and one of them is full, we cannot process your registration and it will be returned to you.
- 5. Upon receipt of your paid registration, you will be a confirmed registrant for your desired class or classes. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt. 
