OUTSTANDING PARKS AND RECREATION PROJECT AWARD FROM THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CIVIL ENGINEERS FOR THE VILLAGE POND PARK / VETERANS PARK RENOVATION (Agenda Item No. 4)

The American Society of Civil Engineers ("ASCE"), Orange County Chapter, recognizes outstanding projects throughout the County. At its annual awards ceremony held in February, the City's Village Pond Park / Veterans Park Renovation Project received the 2019 "Outstanding Parks and Recreation Project of the Year" award for Orange County.

PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF APRIL AS DMV DONATE LIFE CALIFORNIA MONTH (Agenda Item No. 5)

Over 113,000 individuals nationwide and more than 21,000 in California are on the national organ transplant waiting list. To raise awareness, the City Council proclaimed April "DMV Donate Life California Month."

FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) EXPENDITURE PLAN (Agenda Item No. 24)

City Council approved the draft Fiscal Year 2019-20 Community Development Block Grant Expenditure Plan, including program income and prior-year uncommitted funds, and directed staff to return the item to the City Council for final review and adoption on May 21, 2019. If approved, the Expenditure Plan would serve as the basis for the FY 2019-20 Annual Action Plan.

FEE STUDY (Agenda Item No. 25)

City Council discussed the need to update its fee structure and create new fees for the upcoming Civic Center. Based on the recommended Fee Policy, City Council directed staff to schedule a Noticed Public Hearing to formally consider fee adjustments.

The Fee Policy guides the development of an updated fee schedule. The Cost Recovery Guidelines within the Fee Policy are divided into categories ranging from "No Cost" recovery to "Penalties" based on specific criteria within each category.
