# PUBLIC CONSULTATION (SCOPING)

In compliance with the CEQA Guidelines, the City of Lake Forest has provided opportunities for various agencies and the public to participate in the environmental review process. During preparation of the Draft EIR, efforts were made to contact various Federal, State, regional, and local government agencies and other interested parties to solicit comments on the proposed project. This included the distribution of a Notice of Preparation (NOP) for an EIR to various responsible agencies, trustee agencies, and interested parties. The NOP was distributed on May 5, 2011, with the 30-day public review period that started on May 5, 2011 and concluded on June 3, 2011. Comment letters were received from the following responsible agencies, trustee agencies, and interested parties:

- California Department of Transportation, District 12 (letter received June 1, 2011);
- California Cultural Resource Preservation Alliance (letter received June 3, 2011);
- California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (letter received June 10, 2011);
- City of Irvine (letter received June 16, 2011);
- Native American Heritage Commission (letter received May 31, 2011);
- Orange County Fire Authority (letter received May 19, 2011);
- Orange County Public Works (letter received June 7, 2011);
- South Coast Air Quality Management District (letter received May 31, 2011); and



• United States Department of the Interior Fish and Wildlife Service (letter received May 25, 2011).

Additionally, a public scoping meeting held on May 18, 2011 in the Lake Forest City Hall. One attendee from the public was present at the scoping meeting. No environmental concerns for the purpose of the scoping of the EIR was identified at this time.
